Split point data also helps resolve unexpected situations, such as identifying a runner who attempted to shorten the course.

- **Efficient Anomaly Handling:** Any flagged anomalies are immediately communicated to the on-site organiser, who collaborates with school coordinators for confirmation and resolution, often before the last finisher in that wave crosses the line. This streamlined process ensures fair competition and maintains the event's smooth flow.
